

DESCENT REPLACEMENTS

Lost Document:

1. Declaration requesting replacement of lost certificate
2. Police Report attesting to the lost. *Belize police report or US police report
3. Fee US\$100.00 Cash or Money Order made out to the Embassy of Belize or relevant consular office (Miami, New York, Los Angeles or Chicago)
4. 4 Photos (2" X 2") (in keeping with passport photo guidelines)
5. Original and a photocopy of passport or some form of photo identification

Damaged Certificate:

1. Declaration requesting replacement of damaged certificate
2. Original damaged certificate
3. Fee US\$100.00 Cash or Money Order made out to the Embassy of Belize or relevant consular office (Miami, New York, Los Angeles or Chicago)
4. 4 Photos (2" X 2") (in keeping with passport photo guidelines)
5. Original and a photocopy of passport or some form of photo identification

Replacement for Nationality issued by way of a Memo/Letter:

1. Original Memo Letter
2. 4 Photos (2" X 2") (in keeping with passport photo guidelines)
3. Fee US\$100.00 Cash or Money Order made out to the Embassy of Belize or relevant consular office (Miami, New York, Los Angeles or Chicago)
4. Declaration form requesting replacement of nationality memo/letter
5. Copy of passport
6. Original Birth certificate (Official translation if not in English)
7. Parent's Belizean Passport or original birth certificate accompanied by a photo identification

Renunciation of Belizean Citizenship:

1. Declaration requesting renunciation may state reason for doing so.
2. US\$75.00 Cash or Money Order made out to the Embassy of Belize. or relevant consular office (Miami, New York, Los Angeles or Chicago)
3. Applicant must surrender all Belizean Documents: Passport, Voter's ID, and Social Security etc.
4. Original Belize Nationality Certificate or Belize Birth Certificate
5. Completed Section 17 forms (must be done in triplicate) (This requires specific paper from Immigration.)

If Belizean documents cannot be located and are being reported lost or stolen, a declaration must be provided along with a police report attesting to that fact.

Signatures on forms/declaration must be similar to that of identification provided.
